

Caspar McCloud Missionary Tour to U.K

Many of us first met Caspar when we watched the TBN Video that chronicles his miraculous healing. He dropped to the floor during a worship service, and it was not some 'falling out' in the Spirit. His heart was actually no longer beating, and he had no pulse. A doctor and a nurse in the congregation confirmed this, and there wasn't enough time for 911 to arrive before something had to be done quickly to save his life.

How many of you know when there's no pulse, you need God? He was then prayed for and literally raised from the dead after the pastor of that congregation cast the spirit of death out of him in the presence of many witnesses. His miraculous testimony still encourages. The video, which you can still watch on YouTube, is just the beginning of knowing the heart of this gentle giving man, his love for God, and the depth of prayer and ministry Caspar does on a daily basis.

What few know is that Caspar has been ministering for many years and is the Senior Pastor at the Upper Room Fellowship in Georgia. He daily he pours his life and gifts out to minister healing and blessing to others on the front lines at great personal cost to himself and his family. It is not an easy road to pass on a secular music career in the limelight, and trust God with everything in you, especially if you have a family who needs you to care for them as well. Past fame and popularity can make you a target for public exposure and misunderstanding, as the world does not understand the miraculous power of God.



Yet with a clear pure heart of "freely you have received, freely give," Caspar continues to follow and obey God much like how David, in obscurity, cared for the flock entrusted to him. That preparation served David well as God raised him and prospered him because he was a man after God's own heart. As surely as God knows you and I deeply, He knows Caspar's heart of great caring for people. I'd like you to get to know him a little, so you know how to pray, to encourage and to support him as he follows God's lead to travel to the UK in faith on a missionary tour this fall to extend God's blessing back to Great Britain.

It takes prompting from God, confirmation, and subsequent planning and resource to follow God's lead and to trust others to care for church and home while traveling overseas. This is not something done lightly or without lots of prayer. It is even more challenging when a gifted, talented, artist and musician divests himself of the secular venues for compensation in order to give of himself in ways our culture considers "of no reputation," but then we know Some One who also made himself of no reputation to love and give Himself for us. Caspar's just being another 'son', responding to the desires of Our All-loving "Dad." That being

said, it is a huge undertaking and requires prayer and practical financial help, and so I'm writing to share and encourage you to support Caspar, and to help him as he travels to the United Kingdom to pour blessing there this fall. Come hear how his commission to go back to the UK came about, in Caspar's own words. He tells the story of how God prompted him, and shares a bit about their needs:

"About six months ago while praying, I heard the Lord say, 'I am sending you back to the UK this year to minister in My name.' I thought maybe I heard wrong. I really do not have that desire much anymore; the long flights, time changes, leaving my family and church even for a few weeks.

*A little later I checked my email and my music agent friend Steve Nagel asked what it would take to bring me and my band Three to the UK? About an half-hour later I find a Facebook note from a women in London who just watched my teaching series, **Exposing the Spirit of Self-Pity** (now a book on Amazon), saying she repented as she recognized the truth I was sharing.*

A few days later, I got a call from a passionate Irishman named Pat Buckley, whom I'd previously never met or spoken to before, who said that as he was praying the Lord told him to accompany me to minister in the UK. This was quite the shock as I had not spoken to anyone publicly about going to Britain to minister at that point. It turned out that he worked with Curry Blake in John G. Lake's ministry and held large crusades in Pakistan with Hamilton Filmalter where some 150,000 people gathered for open-air healing meetings. Many were saved and converted and supernaturally healed by the Lord Jesus. So I prayed with my wife, Joan, and she agreed it appears the Lord is calling me back to the UK. In the United Kingdom,

mosques are replacing churches at a very alarming rate. We'll be ministering through music, sharing my 2001 testimony shown on TBN and preaching a message to share Christ's love with those who desperately need to hear the Gospel. We would really appreciate your prayers for this mission. You can really make a world of difference as we go to reach out to those people who are lost, hurting and feeling unwanted."

Travel to the U.K. and equipment needing to be transported means that finances are need to cover basic expenses. They have an immediate need to raise at least \$4000 to help cover the cost of travel.
